AGSA Reports 1974-1995 (Defence)

- 1. See 1990 special report on the CCB. This details CCB funding irregularities and important audit deficiencies throughout most of the 1980's. A very useful critique of the limited nature of SDA/Secret Fund audits in that period.
- 2. Infoplan: See annual expenditure and sharp increase from the early 1980's
- Tabulate and calculate the total SDA expenditiure over the period then look at Armscor figures and AGSA report to the AG. Note large increase in expenditure from 1989/90 – 1994/95. What explains this other than currency depreciation (if anything?)
- 4. **General Report:** Note that the General Report is missing (notes from AGSA office in hand) for the years: 82-83; 83-84; 84-85; 86-87; 87-88. There are also no general reports from 1990-1995 (not sure what the value of these are to us).
- 5. **Quality of reports**: Note that the quality of reports shows incremental improvement. This is most evident when Wronsley takes over as AG in 1989/90 [end of PW Botha era].
- 6. State shares in Armscor: There is a record of state shares in Armcor for a number of years and then this information is excluded. Each each share is valuated at a nominal R1. Its unclear what this money was used for and how it was to be accounted for. Established the following total (cumalitive) at the end of each year:
