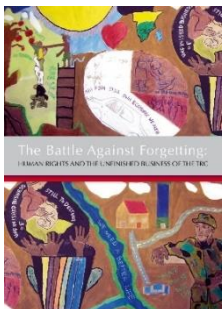

Indians Can't Fly is an awardwinning documentary that tells the story of Ahmed Timol, a 29-year-old Roodepoort teacher and anti-apartheid activist who fell from the 10th floor of the security police building in Johannesburg in 1971. A police inquest concluded that Timol committed suicide while under interrogation, but questions remain whether he may have been pushed, or tortured to death and thrown from the window. It has been suggested that the roadblock at which Timol was captured was set up specifically to trap him – which could mean his murder was premeditated by police. Nobody responsible for his capture and interrogation has ever been held accountable.

The documentary is narrated by Timol's nephew Imtiaz Ahmed Cajee, author of *Timol: Quest for Justice*.

This screening will be followed by a panel discussion on the contemporary ramifications of the unfinished business of the TRC, hosted by SAHA and the Ahmed Timol Family Trust.
