


# WE NEVER GIVE UP

## FILM SCREENING THURSDAY 5 MAY, 17H30 FOR 18H00

Two documentary films produced by the Human Rights Media Centre (HMRC), *We Never Give Up* and *We Never Give Up II*, follow the stories of Khulumani Support Group members in the Western Cape, who suffered multiple atrocities during apartheid. The first film, produced in 2002, highlights the exclusion of survivors of apartheid-era gross human rights violations by the South African Truth and Reconciliation Commission, and the battle for final reparations by those included. Ten years later, *We Never Give Up II*, documents the continuing struggles by survivors as they campaign for comprehensive and inclusive reparations from the Department of Justice and Constitutional Development, and from multinationals that knowingly aided and abetted apartheid.

This screening of the second film *We Never Give Up II* will be followed by a Q&A about the films and a panel discussion about the ongoing reparations battle, hosted by the documentary's producer Shirley Gunn of HRMC.
